	<ul> <li>2019-20 School-wide Priorities</li> <li>Progress on Priorities (focus on Re-Authorization)</li> <li>Emily and Ryan presented on the authorization process and the outcomes from the 9/4 Budget Committee and 9/9 Curriculum</li> <li>Committee hearings. It was noted that no legal findings for denial had been identified by the District, yet concerns were raised around suspension and expulsions. 	The Board also discussed the rationale and implications of the District's decision to split the Petition into K-5 and 6-8. Ryan and Emily presented the school's approach, including making the legal case against the split.	
	The Board emphasized the need to uphold our school's values in the authorization process, to hold out the possibility of partnership with the District and to continue to "put our best foot forward." Ryan and Emily walked through the school's approach to our final hearing, including the speaker slate and key messages.

The school's cash position is strong due to multi-year commitments. It was confirmed that any adjustments (specifically increases) to the budget will be determined later in the year if funds are available.</li> <li>Presentation of 2018-19 Unaudited Financials</li> <li>Action: 2018-19 Unaudited Financials approved</li> <li>2018-19 Fundraising Overview</li> <li>Emily presented on the school's fundraising outlook for the year and the path towards reaching our annual target. The Board sought further details around the need for new commitments to meet our goals and the capacity of the school to meet those goals.
